Papers focused on Latin America and the Caribbean or on issues relevant for the region will be given priority. We welcome submissions from underrepresented universities, countries, and individuals.

Abstracts must not exceed 500 words. Decisions are expected to be announced by October 15, 2024. Submissions will be accepted in English, Spanish and Portuguese.
